I joined the Army in 1989 to serve in the Household Cavalry. After gaining Equine management qualifications I went on to join the armoured side of the regiment. Here I became a Tank Crewman attaining Engineering Maintenance and various other vehicle related qualifications, serving on both CVRT, Chieftain & Challenger MBT's. Both types of vehicle operate computerised fire control systems which require training and live firing experience to become qualified which gives you a qualification as an application specialist. To achieve this you have to be

able to programme, repair, setup onboard and remote fire control systems and also be able to fly by wire swing fire missiles. Other systems in use were the Ptarmigan Network Satellite Communications Systems, MCLOS and SACLOS & TOGS Training is carried out at trade training schools such as in Harrogate, Catterick and Pirbright When you have completed armoured role training, you will learn more about your own reconnaissance vehicle, and become an Advanced Driver, Signaler or Gunner. The Household Cavalry also offered the opportunity to gain further qualifications such as Assistant Riding Instructor, Saddler, Tailor or Farriery at the Household Cavalry Mounted Regiment.

Qualifications Gained in Service: NVQ 2 Engineering Maintenance, NVQ 2 Equine Management, NVQ 2 Application Specialist (Information technology, communications and data specialist), Further education in Intelligence, Surveillance, Target Acquisition and Reconnaissance (ISTAR) Operator.



When Windows 95 was introduced as a stable OS for MOD purpose, most of our equipment became reliant on such systems. This gave me first hand use with Windows as systems such as Ptarmigan relied on new technology. Having worked on ISTAR, the computer became the tool of the trade, transferring, decoding and recovering data and information; courses on it then became compulsory. I decide to leave the Army in 1997 and settled on a 3 week condensed IT course to expand on my knowledge and this

was based on Windows 95, this gave me more knowledge on software and other applications from hardware and software installations and peripherals.



I joined NCR in 1997 and worked mainline building ATM's. This gave me chance to learn how to build tower based pc and run software such as Win 2000, NT and XP and also learn to operate debugging software for fault finding. Later on I was introduced into Hardware test using a specially built test rig to test components for use in ATM's using the latest test tools and software.

After 10 years in the industry I joined Glaxo Smithkline Pharmaceuticals as a Chemical Technician. Here I learned the use of SAP system and also gained various qualifications to include eRepository to become a data custodian. The advancement of technology has encouraged me to learn more

and gain knowledge of the most recent Operating Systems in order to help service, maintain and repair, even upgrade pc systems. This is my history in brief, just a quick overview of my time with IT.
